

A STORY TO LIGHTEN UP YOUR DAY

Besides buying your clutch from Honda, there is another after market made by Barnett, but the catch is to find it you have to look under Valkyrie.

Chapter Educator Section



Well, here we are already into April, Spring is here, and for the most part riding has returned. Sadly, for me, as most of you know, my riding season probably won't resume until sometime in July, due to my recent shoulder surgery. Enough about me, let's talk about a basic riding concern - intersections.

Though it's true that most cycle vs. auto crashes occur at intersections, let's put aside the most frequent type of "the auto lefty turner" for this article. Today, I would like to focus on just getting through intersections safely without getting stuck blocking traffic behind some car, and without getting rearended by an inattentive auto driver. If you have been paying attention in moderate traffic, the pedestrian crossing signals should be a good guide indicating when traffic signals are about to change.

Good clues to "stale" green lights are pedestrian signals that display the flashing hand, a solidly lit hand, or the popular flashing countdown numeric timer telling you when the traffic signal will change. Depending on your distance from the intersection, using these guidelines should allow you to make a safe decision whether or not to start slowing and then stop for the upcoming red light.

Hey, nobody likes to run red lights, but nobody wants to get rearended either as was mentioned earlier. If it appears that the auto following you seems too close for the coming red light, keep the right corner of your lane available as a safety zone.

- I-75 North to Exit 134 (Caryville, Jacksboro, LaFollette).
- At bottom of ramp turn right (east) on TN-63/US-25W.
- Turn right in approx. 9 miles, after going thru town, at Traffic Light #10, Cumberland Avenue.
- Road name changes to Old Long Hollow Road (follow signs to Deerfield Resort every mile or so).
- Turn left in about 3.8 miles onto Cedar Creek Road (just past Coolidge Baptist Church).
- Turn right in about 3.8 miles onto Alder Springs Road.
- Bear right in about 1 mile, up the hill onto Chapman Rd (you'll see signs to Deerfield Resort.)
- You'll come to the guard shack in about a mile let them know that you're visiting us. Note: the road name changes to Deerfield Way at the guard shack.
- Turn right in about 2 miles at office and tennis courts (you'll still be on Deerfield Way after turning).
- Go down the hill and turn at the first street, Deerwood Lane.


