December, yeah I get it, not much riding, cold weather, and it's the holiday season. Well, if the weather gets nice for a day or so you're probably tempted to go out for a ride. So let's discuss something you very rarely, if ever hear about: HEARING LOSS! And you say "Say What"?

Our sport is a major contributor to permanent hearing loss. This occurs slowly over time. Now if many of you were "Later in life" motorcyclists and have only known Gold Wings, then you have a great advantage. Many of us who started riding at an early age however, are not so lucky. Many of us have been riding for over 50 years and have been exposed to various demons that over time damaged our hearing. Bikes without windshields, poor fitting helmets, and loud pipes are just a few contributors.

We all know that Gold Wings are quiet by design and that even the stock windshield and fairing provide good protection from wind noise, but some aftermarket windshields offer even greater protection from the wind. Finding a good quiet helmet or getting fitted for custom molded earpiece speakers will also afford better protection from wind noise.

If you still ride a second bike or scooter consider using the store bought foam earplugs available at sporting goods stores to help reduce wind noise. Also, if your second bike is a cruiser or sport bike, keep the intake and exhaust systems stock to avoid hearing damage. We know that hearing loss comes with age, but taking some precautions can help put it off so we can enjoy riding to a later age.

With Chapter B members having had another good riding season in 2016, I'll close by wishing you all a happy holiday season and remember:



Soft Christmas Cookies

- 3 3/4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1 teaspoon baking powder
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
 - 1 cup margarine, softened
- 1 1/2 cups white sugar
- 2 eggs
- 2 teaspoons vanilla extract
- Add all ingredients to list



- 1. Sift flour, baking powder, and salt together, set aside. In a large bowl, cream together the margarine and sugar until light and fluffy. Beat in the eggs one at a time, then stir in the vanilla. Gradually blend in the sifted ingredients until fully absorbed. Cover dough, and chill for 2 hours.
- 2. Preheat oven to 400 degrees F (200 degrees C). Grease cookie sheets. On a clean floured surface, roll out small portions of chilled dough to 1/4 inch thickness. Cut out shapes using cookie cutters.
 - 3. Bake 6 to 8 minutes in the preheated oven, or until edges are barely brown. Remove from cookie sheets to cool on wire racks.













Christmas Stew

Ingredients:

- 3/4 pound shallots, peeled and halved lengthwise
- 2 1/2 pounds beef stew meat, cut into 2-inch pieces
- Kosher salt and freshly ground pepper
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 3 onions, chopped

- 1 cup chopped celery
- 1/4 cup red wine
- 4 cups beef stock
- 1/2 teaspoon dried thyme
- 1/2 teaspoon dried rosemary
- 1/8 teaspoon dried marjoram
- 3 large potatoes, peeled and quartered
- 4 carrots, peeled and cut into 2-inch slices
- 1 (10-ounce) package frozen peas

1. Preheat oven to 375°F.

2. Season the beef liberally with salt and pepper. Heat the oil in the French oven over medium-high heat. Add the beef and cook, stirring as needed, until browned on all sides, about 2 minutes per side. Transfer to a plate. 3. Discard any excess oil from the pan and return to medium-high heat. Add the onions and celery and cook until soft, about 3 minutes. Add the wine and stir, scraping the bottom and sides with a wooden spoon. Stir in the stock, thyme, rosemary and marjoram. Return the meat and any juices that have collected to the pot. Add the potatoes and carrots, then cover and bake for 3 hours. Stir in the peas and bake for 1 hour. Season to taste with salt and pepper

I-75 to Emory Road Exit. From the South going North on 75, take the off ramp and go right onto East Emory Road.

From the North going south, take the Emory Road exit and turn left. Go under the interstate on East Emory Road.

You will go approximately 7 miles on Emory Road to Maynardville Highway. Along the way you will pass Tennova Hospital on your left, Bruster's Ice Cream on your right, Weigel's on your right (just past a traffic light). Go across Norris Freeway at the next traffic light - still on Emory Road - you will see a large empty building on your right - Walmart used to be there - and Aldi on your left. Go straight through a traffic light and past Beaver Dam Baptist Church on your right to another traffic light. This will be the corner of Maynardville Highway (or Highway 33) and Emory Road. Go across Maynardville Highway - still on Emory Road. CVS will be on your right and Commercial Bank will be on your left.

Go approximately 3 miles to Huntington Place subdivision – turn right into subdivision-Foxglen Blvd. – go to the end of the boulevard and turn right on Trinity – go past 1 house and turn left on Foxbranch Circle – go past 4 houses and turn left on Inverrary Circle. 


