G 1800 Brake Recal

Torrance, CA: American Honda Motor Co., Inc. has notified the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration (NHTSA) that a potential defect relating to motor vehicle safety exists in the secondary master cylinder on certain 2001-2010 and 2012 model year GL1800 motorcycles. Situation:

The compensating port hole inside the secondary master cylinder (part of the combined-braking system) can become blocked due to (1) stacking of tolerances in manufacturing and (2) sufficient swelling of the primary pressure cup inside the master cylinder. If the compensating port hole becomes completely blocked, the rear wheel brake caliper can drag after the rider releases the brake input. If this occurs, the rear brake temperature and pressure progressively increase. Unexpected braking increases the risk of a crash and continued riding with the brake engaged can generate enough heat to cause the rear brake to catch fire. Inspection and Repair:

Honda motorcycle dealers will inspect the secondary master cylinder of all affected motorcycles in dealership stock or sold to customers (consumers and commercial entities). If an inspection indicates that the compensator port hole can become blocked due to this problem, the dealer will replace the secondary master cylinder. Registered owners of affected motorcycles will be contacted by mail and asked to take their motorcycle to a Honda dealer. The dealer will inspect the motorcycle, and if necessary, replace the secondary master cylinder, free of charge.

Additional Details:

Honda motorcycle dealers will immediately receive a transmittal of complete repair instructions. Replacement secondary master cylinders in the U.S. will initially be made available through American Honda's dealer technical support hotline. Upon approval by NHTSA, American Honda will mail a letter to all registered owners, and also post a copy of the letter on the Honda Brand website: pow-ersports.honda.com. Target dates for website posting are before the end of December 2011, and mail receipt by registered customers should occur before the end of January 2012.

Honda apologizes for any inconvenience this creates, but feels the safety of our customers is the highest priority. Honda encourages every cus-

Holiday Recipes

Cream Cheese Danish

2 8oz pkg. of cream cheese

2 Pkg. Pillsbury Crescent Rolls

3/4 C. Sugar Smucker's strawberry 'Simply Fruit'

Pre-heat the oven to 350*, Spray a 9x13 pan with Pam or other non-stick spray. Spread 1 pkg. crescent rolls in bottom of pan. Mix sugar and softened cream cheese. Spread on top of

the crescent rolls in the pan, top lightly with some of the strawberry spread. Roll out the other can of crescent rolls on top of this and bake at 350* for 20-25 minutes. This recipe is good for a holiday brunch:

Topping for Danish:

1 Cup Powdered Sugar

2-3 tablespoons water

. 1/2 tablespoon vanilla

Mix together and spoon on top of the Danish while it is hot. Refrigerate any leftovers.



German Chocolate Upside-Down Cake

1 Box German Chocolate Cake Mix
2 Cups Sweetened Flake Coconut
1 Stick Butter (melted)
8 oz Cream Cheese

Pre-heat oven to 350* - Grease & flour a 9x13 baking pan - Sprinkle the coconut in the bottom of the pan and sprinkle pecans over the coconut. Mix cake mix <u>as directed</u> on the box and pour it over the coconut and nuts. Mix the powdered sugar, cream cheese and melted butter together and pour or spoon it on top of the cake mix. Bake at 350* for approximately 45 minutes. Cool and leave in the pan to serve. (This cake is ugly but very good!)

Pineapple Casserole

2 Large cans of <u>drained</u> pineapple chunks

1 Cup of Sugar

1 stick of melted butter

1 roll of crushed Ritz crackers

6 Tablespoons Flour

3 Cups of fresh grated cheddar cheese don't use shredded in bag)

Pre-heat oven to 350*, Spray a 9x13 dish with Pam. Mix the sugar and flour in a bowl. Add the drained pineapples and grated cheese and pour in the 9x13 pan. Top with the crushed Ritz crackers and pour the melted butter on top. Bake at 350* for 30 - 45 minutes. (This is good with the main course, but some eat it as a dessert. Either way it is goodood!)

Steak Dinner in a Foil Package

1 1/2 lb. chuck steak, 1" thick

1 can cream of mushroom or cream of celery soup

1 envelope dehydrated onion soup mix

3 med. carrots, quartered

2 stalks celery, cut into 2" lengths

2 to 3 med. potatoes, pared and quartered

2 T. water

Heat oven to 450. Tear off 2 feet of heavy-duty foil, 18" wide; lay in baking pan. Place meat in center. Mix mushroom soup and on-

ion soup mix; spread over meat. Top with vegetables. Sprinkle veggies with water. Fold foil over and seal securely to hold in juices. Bake 1 1/2 hr or until meat is tender. 4 servings Very good--easy --enjoy!



O-HENRY BARS

1 c. sugar1 c. corn syrup1 1/2 c. peanut butter

6 c. corn flakes 1 (12-oz) pkg. chocolate chips

Mix sugar and corn syrup in a saucepan. Bring to a boil; remove and add peanut butter. Pour over cereal and mix well. Spread in a buttered deep cookie sheet. Bake 20 min. in 350 oven. While warm, melt chocolate chips and spread over top. Cool and cut into squares. Yield: 40 cookies






