- 1/8 Cup Milk, Scalded
- 1 Tablespoon Yeast
- 3 Tablespoons Honey
- 3 Tablespoons oil
- 1/2 Teaspoon salt

3 Eggs, beatenRind of 1 Lemon1 Teaspoon Cinnamon2 Cups whole wheat flour6 Large apples, thinly sliced

Soften yeast in milk. Add honey, oil and salt. Allow to stand until bubbly. Add eggs, rind and cinnamon. Stir in flour, Knead well. Put into oiled bowl. Cover . Set in warm place for 3 hours to rise. Turn onto floured board. Knead again and roll out very thin. Spread on oiled cookie sheet. Brush with oil. Arrange rows of apples over dough. Let stand in warm place for 30 minutes. Bake in preheated 400 degree oven for 30 minutes. To serve, cut into squares, put a dab of yogurt or sour cream on each square. Serves 8

#### Favorite Chocolate Cake

3/4 Cup soft lard (scant)2 Cups sugar2 Eggs2 Teaspoon SodaCake1/2 Teaspoon baking power

Pinch salt 3/4 Cup cocoa 1 1/2 Cup boiling water 2 1/2 Cup flour

Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Put in mixing bowl, lard, sugar, eggs, soda, baking powder, salt and cocoa, add 1/2 cup boiling water and mix well. Stir in flour, then add 1 cup boiling water. Bake in 9 x 13 x 2" or 2 layer pans 30 to 40 minutes. Serves 12

## **Chapter Ecucator Section**



Probably February is not the time you think much about your two wheeler, especially with snow on the ground! The problems that situations like this present are several. The bike has been parked several months since we rode it and maybe we didn't spend as much time after the past riding season to check the bike over before parking it. Now as soon as the weather out gets warm we'll be all excited about taking a short ride and enjoy some of the warm weather. How often has this happened to you?


First thing is we just don't think about is that our riding skills are a bit rusty at their best. Second is your bike, is it ready to head down the road? We may not want to take the time to check the air pressure, make sure the brakes are in good shape, check the oil, and all the usual things needed to prepare the bike to hit the road because we are anxious to ride. All we want to do is just hit the road and enjoy the nice weather.


The skills needed to handle your bike safely are many and they need to be practiced to remain sharp. As long as we realize we may not be as sharp as we were during the height of the riding season, and we are just a bit more careful, it may save us from an embarrassing moment.

Tire pressures always go down when the bike is left to set for months; not really sure why but it has to with the temperature fluctuations. Don't let the sudden temperature rise make you take unnecessary chances - take the time to properly check the bike over and be very careful the first time out. A rider skills course is highly recommended. Even as an experienced rider, these courses can help all of us sharpen the skills we have and maybe teach us some techniques. We will help those interested in one of these courses to get registered. Please think about this and let me know. Springtime is a good time to take a course.

Also, we have an opportunity to take a first aid and CPR course through GWRRA. This Med-First class is good for 2 years and can be arranged through Norm Sorrell, our District Educator. There are several chapters in our area scheduling some of the courses to update their certification. We may be able to sit in on one of their classes if we let them know in time. I will be glad to check out class availability for you, just let me know.

Spring time is just around the corner, lets get in gear now so we can all be ready to ride (Safely) when the time comes. Remember keep the shiny side up and the rubber side down and ride safe.


