The 7th Annual Mountain Man Memorial March is scheduled for 12 April 2014 in Gatlinburg. Mark your calendars, be prepared to come out and help us honor Gold Star Families and their fallen heroes.

The Mountain Man Memorial March began as a way to honor 1LT Frank B. Walkup, IV. 1LT Walkup, a 2005 University of Tennessee graduate and ROTC alumnus was killed in action in Iraq in 2007 when an improvised explosive device detonated near his vehicle. Upon learning of the death of 1LT Walkup a group of UT Cadets were looking for a way to honor 1LT Walkup and his family and the Mountain Man Memorial March was born.

The inaugural MMMM was held in Gatlinburg, TN in April of 2008 with 40 Cadets from East Tennessee ROTC programs. The inaugural MMMM consisted of a 26.2 mile march with each Cadet carrying a 35 pound ruck sack. The UT Ranger team carried a picture of 1LT Walkup and presented it along with a Gold Star flag, to his mother at the completion of the event. The 2013 MMMM honored over 75 service members from all branches of the US Military and their families. Marchers and runners totaled over 575 from all over the United States.

Each Gold Star Family will be provided, at no cost, 1 room at the River Terrace Inn for Friday 11 April 2014 and Saturday 12 April 2014. These rooms are provided to the families through donations from groups, corporations, and individuals like you and me. The cost to provide a room for both nights is \$150.00.

As a motorcyclist I have participated in this event for four years. On Friday afternoon and evening I and Judy have met with families as they arrive at the hotel welcoming them to the event. In the past here has been an opening ceremony where the marchers meet and greet their Gold Star family. This has always been a very emotional time.

Saturday morning we line our motorcycles up in front of the marchers. As many Gold Star family members as want are given a seat on the back of one of our motorcycles. When the march starts we lead them out part of the way on their march. We manage to get far enough ahead that we can let our passengers get off and cheer their teams on as they pass one of the water stations.

After breakfast we offer to take members of the Gold Star families on a short ride to get them away into the National Park for a little while of relaxation. This has been a fun filled time with the Mothers just relaxing for a little while.

As the marchers return to the finish line we escort them for the last few miles giving them encouragement. The marchers are tired and hurting at this point and the encouragement helps them one their way.

Spring Is Just Around the Corner

As the snow melts away and the days get longer, the desire to experience the wind in your face gets stronger. Motorcyclists across the country are charging batteries, checking tire pressure and putting a good coat of wax on their trusty steed. Making ready for that first warm afternoon, when they can get out on the highway. Harley or Honda, all motorcycle riders look forward to the first spring ride in the country.

After a longest winter many can remember, road crews have worked long hours to keep the roads clear of ice and snow. However there is a very dangerous residual left-over from the plowing process. The sand the highway department used on roads. Loose sand is everywhere in the early Spring, it can be found on corners, intersections, main roads and side streets alike. This accumulation of sand presents a severe danger to all two wheeled vehicles.

Watch out for loose sand at intersections as well. Stopping too fast on a thin layer of sand will send you sliding into the intersection, possibly into the path of cross traffic.

People driving cars forget all about motorcycles during the winter months. Even in good weather in the middle of summer a motorcycle is almost invisible to cars. Our headlights being always on can help, but it's vital that motorcyclists ride with the attitude that

everyone out there is trying to kill you. For all practical purposes they are, be it unintentional, but none the less tangling with a car is the last thing any motorcycle rider wants to do.

Inexperienced riders, new motorcycle owners, will be on the road in large quantities. With the price of gas reaching the stars, more and more people will be opting for the much cheaper to operate motorcycle for daily transportation. Not only should these new riders be extremely cautious as they have a lot to learn about safety, but the experienced rider can find themselves in trouble because of mistakes made by someone with little or no experience.

When you head out on the road this spring, be aware. Know what's going on around you and give yourself enough space to safely navigate around dangers. Motorcycle riding is one of the best ways to experience what our beautiful country has to offer.

You need to stay Friday and Saturday night in order to get this rate, and there is a 7 day cancellation policy. We will stay Thursday thru Sunday.

Wing Ding 36, Madison, Wisconsin, July 2-5, 2014

Those of us who attended Wing Ding 35 in Greenville really had a great time - even in spite of the rain. We can start now to plan for next year's Wing Ding in Madison, WI.

I've checked out a lot of places to stay and this is what I have come up with. GrandStay Residential Suites. All rooms have a kitchen. Some are 2-bedroom and some one-bedroom with private bedroom. The rates are very reasonable. 2-bedroom suite \$116.10, 1-bedroom suite \$80.10, room with 2 queen beds \$89.10. (all beds are queens). Tax is additional at 14.5 %.

Booking.com gives this hotel a 9.2 *wonderful* rating (out of 10). Trip Advisor ranks this hotel at #8 out of 62 hotels.

I have reserved three (3) 2-bedroom suites from Monday 6/30 thru Sunday 7/6. That may be all the 2-bedrooms they have - it would not let me reserve more. If you would like to stay in one that I have reserved, just let me know - and it's OK if you change your mind. So far we have all of these 6 rooms spoken for except for one—if you would like that room let me know. They can be cancelled the day of. And we can change the dates on any or all of the rooms. I just thought it was a good idea to reserve while rooms are still available.

The hotel is about 12 miles and 15 minutes from the rally site. This is the website to check out the hotel and/or to make reservations. http://www.grandstaymadison.com/. FYI, GWRRA's rates for nicer hotels is quite a bit more. So I think this first-rate hotel is a good value for us.
