Saddle Bag Necessities – Making the Jump

Batteries are great until they're not! Most of us ride Goldwings and in case haven't noticed they don't have kick starts and require a lot of juice to run! teries don't always tell you they are getting old either. They tend to just die especially if something electronic is left on and drains it down. For those reait is a good thing to add a portable battery jumper pack to your saddleback. are smaller and cheaper than ever before and should be considered a must for a large motorcycle owner. Here are a few considerations you should think about when purchasing the right batter starter pack for your ride.

Power and Peak Amps: Ensure that the jump starter has sufficient power to your motorcycle. Look for a model with a suitable peak amp rating for your torcycle's engine size. Higher peak amps generally provide more cranking power.

Size and Portability: Choose a compact and lightweight jump starter for easy portability. You'll want a unit that is convenient to carry on your motorcycle or in your backpack.

Safety Features: Look for safety features such as reverse polarity protection, over-current protection, short circuit protection, and overcharge protection. These features help prevent damage to the jump starter and ensure safe usage. **Durability:** Consider the build quality and durability of the jump starter. It should be able to withstand the rigors of being carried on a motorcycle and potentially exposed to different weather conditions.

Other Features such as Multiple Charging Ports and/or Flashlight: Some jump starters come with additional features like USB ports for charging smartphones and other devices. If you want a versatile device, consider one with multiple charging ports. Many also come with built-in flashlights. This can be a handy feature in emergency situations or when working in low-light conditions.

There are other factors like ease of use, reputation of the manufacturer and warranty to consider as well but if you do your research you will find the right one for you.

To conclude, if you don't already have a battery starter jump pack seriously 'start' looking and take the 'jump' into

Over the last 3 years I have been doing research on tires and this is some of my findings on the subject of tires hands down if you are riding a Goldwing Trike for the front wheel is 130/70-18 Bridgestone Battlax BT46 Rear Tire and 42 lbs air pressure I have put several on and have had people bring me tires that they purchased and hands down this tire wares better and is more stable than even Michelin Pilots that cost twice as much



Rear tires on a trike I found this tire to be the best Falken Sincera SN250 A/S at 20 psi work very well and are stable even with that low air pressure

- 1 tub (8 oz) frozen whipped topping, thawed, divided
- 1 Oreo pie crust 6oz
- 5 Oreo cokkies, cut in half

- Refrigerate 4 hours or until firm. Top with remaining whipped topping and cookies just before serving, keep refrigerated.
