Smartphones and Motorcycles Part 1

Smartphones have become a part of almost everyone's life and it is only natural they would become a reality for motorcyclists. However, having a smartphone holder on a motorcycle brings up some very strong opinions among motorcyclists. In this two-part series I will explore the acceptable and unacceptable uses of a smartphone while on a motorcycle.

Let's first address the obvious. There are those that are vehemently opposed to smartphones being mounted on handlebars and usually use the argument about safety. It is a veryt good and valid argument. I recall watching a video was filmed and published by a motorcyclist YouTuber who shared a video of himself accessing his smartphone while riding and going right off the road. Fortunately, he wasn't going very fast and when he went into the grassy area on the side of the road and the bike when down the only thing he hurt was his pride. He chose to share the video it to make the point that attempting to interact with your smartphone while riding a motorcycle is NOT a good idea. I agree with him completely. Who wouldn't?

Now, before you think that this means 'case closed' let's talk about what could be considered safe uses of your smartphone while riding.

One of the most common uses of a smartphone on a motorcycle is listening to music. Many of you have your smartphone connected to your motorcycle via Bluetooth or a direct cable. This allows you to play your streaming music platform (such as Spotify or Apple Music) and listen to your favorite tunes. But it is vitally important that you select the playlist or music channel before you leave your driveway and only change it when you are parked in a safe location. While your engine is running, and you are in traffic you can't afford to have anything take your attention anywhere else but what is going on around you. Another practical use of a smartphone while riding is for navigation. Plugging in a route on your phone and starting that route BEFORE you let your clutch out is something many bikers do. It is the equivalent of a motorcyle equipped with navigation (like many Goldwings have). The only interaction you have with your smartphone while you are riding is to just glance at the route from time to time. Many of you have done this with built-in navigation systems successfully for years. It is just as safe to use your smartphone in the same manner as long as you don't actually try to USE your smartphone while riding or even at a stoplight.

For those that have Bluetooth helmets that connect to your smartphone you may be able to take phone calls while riding using voice commands. I spoke with someone recently while they were riding. The good thing about this is they did not have to take their eyes off the road or touch their phone. Very similar to 'hands free' use of a smartphone in a car. Again, the handsfree part is essential.

Next month we will talk about how a smartphone should never be used on a motorcycle. I bet you can guess what those are!


