So, if you are considering purchasing a new pair of riding boots you may want to consider a riding shoe. They will give you most of the protection of a boot with a lot more comfort.

<u>Riding Boots or Shoes</u>

When it comes to riding we all want to be comfortable (especially as we get older). We want to have comfortable seats, helmets, gloves, etc. and one of the biggest areas of comfort is our footwear. We all want comfortable footwear when we ride as we are going to be wearing them all day long and often doing a lot of walking around during our breaks.

Now, I don't know about you but I've had many different pairs of boots and shoes in my life but I have never had a pair of boots that were as comfortable as my favorite pair of shoes. Why is that? Well, because shoes tend to be made for walking and pleasure where boots are typically made for

a specific purpose like working, hiking, etc., and because of that, have a significant function of safety and protection. And you can't always protect your feet as comfortably as you would like. I think of the medieval knight in his armor, and I often wonder how amazingly uncomfortable that armor must have been!

Motorcycle boots have always been the 'standard' when it comes to riding. Obviously the motorcycle boot is the most common and there are a wide range

of riding boots from the traditional black leather boot with the distinct heel all the way to the custom molded boot that is specifically made for competitive riding. However, recently there has been a movement towards motorcycle 'shoes'. These shoes are designed with the idea to give the comfort of a tennis shoe yet still providing some of the protection that comes with boots such as

anti-skid soles, reinforced toe for shifting and side protection for the ankle. Now, most of these are over the ankle but just barely and won't provide as much protection as a boot but they are much more safe than a standard shoe because they are made for riding.

Riding shoes are comparable in price to boots and are known for their comfort and also offer the rider more stylish options. Some of the manufacturers that make motorcycle shoes are Taspoyo, D3O, Dainese and many more. A Google search for 'motorcycle shoe' will bring you to many options.


















