


Region N Gookbook

Room Possibilities for Wing Ding in Hunstville, AL, September 3-6, 2015

Note: We have reserved our rooms for Wednesday 9/2 (the day of the Couple of the Year Selection) through Sunday 9/6 (day of closing ceremonies) - 4 nights. Reservations can be made now with the convention center-confirmed after Labor Day. Those hotels not on the list cannot be made until after Labor Day (one year in advance.)

This list includes hotels with reviews in or near the top 50%, and which are less than the \$109 rate at the Homewood Suites, where we have reserved 2 (this is all they have) two-bedroom, 2 bath suites. One bedroom has a king and the other has 2 queens. This hotel is .6 mile from the rally site, within walking distance for many of us.

The rate for these units is \$218 (twice the price of a regular room). The unit has a living room and a full kitchen. Other regular rooms are available at the rate of \$109. The web-site shows some rooms have 2 queen beds, some one king bed, and some have a separate bedroom - all have kitchens and sitting areas - call the convention center. 256-551-2380. I spoke with Leslie Walker. You can book any of the rooms on the second list with her. (I didn't ask her if it is necessary to register for Wing Ding first - we had already registered in Madison.)

Look over the list - we need to decide what is more important: location, rating, price, type of accommodation. Even though we have made reservations, that can be changed. Something for us to think about.

"Hey Good Buddy" - Let's talk about CB Radio Chatter

An old friend of mine and a fellow Chapter Educator recently spoke to his members about use and misuse of our CB radios, so I thought it might be a good idea for us to review some CB basics. Group riding is always safer and more enjoyable when everyone in the group can understand the directions to the next destination as being given by your ride / group leader. That being said, it is imperative that with larger groups, or multiple groups, that idle chatter be kept to a minimum so the leader and back door guy / gal of the group (s) have an open channel for their communication and making announcements to the group. Limiting the use of the CB for idle chatter is particularly critical during departures and arrivals.

For good to excellent communication while riding down the highway CB's can't be beat. They're better than hand signals, and much better than the old days when we had to shout at each other! When transmitting, key the "mike" and wait a second or two before

talking while the radio comes up to power. CB radios in motorcycles are notoriously underpowered in the first place. Also, it's not like you're using a telephone with a two way conversation. The CB is called a two way radio, but it only works one way at a time! While ON-LY one person is talking all others tuned to the same channel within range will hear him / her, however when two or more key up to transmit at the same time NOBODY can hear the message. We all know this as "doubling". In this age of instant communication with cellphones, skype, etc. we are still limited (for now anyway) to this rather basic type of radio communication. So let's make the best of it.

If you're having difficulty hearing others talk via your small helmet speakers, try using the fairing mounted speakers. They are almost five times larger than the ones in your helmet and may be the best way to go for you.

Another point to remember: If your corider is talking to you on the intercom and either of you press the transmit buttons, everyone in the group will hear what is being said. That could be a big OOPS!

Once again, while on a group ride during the time we first start out and when coming to a rest stop, gas stop, or food break, we should give up the CB use to the group leader and the "back door" guy / gal. It's just a matter of safety. After all, we are coming to a stop and we can take the helmet off and talk like real people!


